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# Have Confidence

*This Family Group Bible-Talk is intended to supplement the November 3rd sermon at the MSPCOC. Although having attended or listened to that lesson is helpful, it is not required to take part in the following discussion.*

## **Opening Questions:**

- Can you think of a time when you had to meet with someone and you absolutely lacked confidence to do so?
- Why did you lack confidence?
- What causes us to be confident when meeting with some people but lack confidence with others?
- Read Leviticus 16:1-2
- Why do you think God was so serious about people coming into his presence under the Old Covenant?
- What are some reasons that we would lack confidence coming into the presence of God?
- Why would Aaron be able to enter with confidence?

## **Read: Hebrews 10:19-21**

### **Group Questions:**

- Why is it so significant that we have “confidence to enter the Most Holy Place”?
- What does it mean for us to enter into God’s presence?
- Why can we be confident?

## **Read: Hebrews 10:22**

### **Group Questions:**

- How do you “draw near to God”?
- Why do you think the author adds “with a sincere heart”?
- How does faith bring full assurance? Why is it important to have full assurance?

## **Read: Hebrews 10:23**

### **Group Questions:**

- What are the things that can cause us to waver or swerve in holding to the hope we profess?

- Do you feel like you are wavering in anything right now?
- What can we do if we do find that we are wavering?

**Read: Hebrews 10:24**

**Group Questions:**

- How can we spur one another on to love and good deeds? Why is that so important?
- How can that help us draw near to God and keep from swerving from our faith?

**Read: Hebrews 10:25**

**Group Questions:**

- Why do you think the author warned them against getting into the habit of giving up meeting together?
- How does being devoted to meeting together help us to draw near to God and do so without wavering?

**Final Thought:**

- What can you do this week to spur another brother or sister on to love and good deeds?



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
