Hope is God returns and renews the world

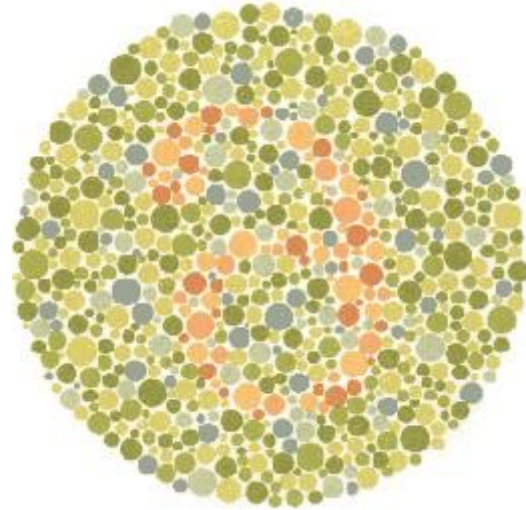

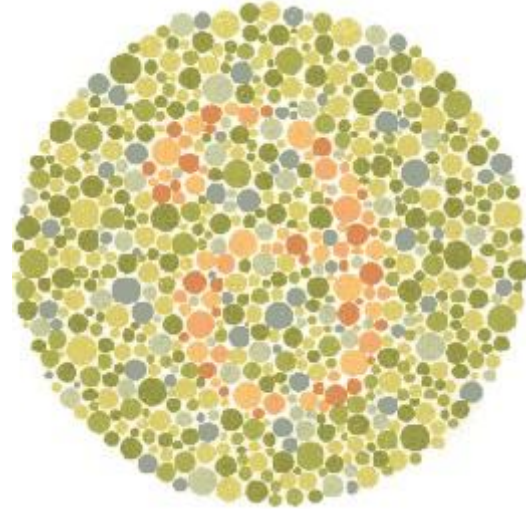
